The annual District 93 conference held in May celebrates its 10th anniversary this year! The 2020 District 93 conference committee is working hard to prepare the conference so that the members can DIVE DEEP into Toastmasters this spring. For those who are curious about the conference or thinking about attending, the 2020 District 93 Conference PR Chair, Melanie Oh, would like to share some information with you.

IT'S THE 10TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION AND WE ARE GOING BIG!

District 93 Toastmasters is celebrating its 10th anniversary at the annual conference this May 16 -17 at Seoul Women's Plaza. The 2020 District 93 Conference is a 2-day event for all toastmasters across the nation plus several invited international guests to learn and share communication and leadership skills, and watch the best of the best speakers from District 93 compete in the district speech contests.

This event features two invited speakers, plus more than 10 workshops including hands-on demonstrations of communication and leadership techniques. The first day will end with an ever-exciting evening program and an after-party preceded by a fancy dinner with more than 300 expected attendees.

The second day will have the long-awaited district speech contests. The winner from the International Speech Contest will have the change to move on to the 2020 Toastmasters International Convention in Paris, France. Members are also invited to compete in Table Topics contests which will be held in both Korean and English.

One of the speakers, Josephine Lee, is a respected entrepreneur and an international award winning speaker. Coming in 3rd place in the 2016 World Championship of Public Speaking, she has established herself as the first Korean American woman to place on the final stage. Since becoming a master of public speaking, she has been invited to give keynote speeches in many countries including a TEDx in Culver City, U.S.A.

Continuing with our theme of celebrating the 10th anniversary, there will be side events for all things related to District 93 Toastmasters, plus various fun networking and game sessions all throughout the event.
